



Col	Category	Description & Controlled Vocabulary
1	Monument #	Randomly assigned number correlating to a map (where applicable).
2	Image #	<p>Image number, corresponding with file name to connect with photographic records.</p> <p>Monuments were photographed using a scale bar, a north arrow and an identification card (with monument number and site location).</p> 
3	Image URL	Link to image file.
4	Sequence	<p>Database records are based on commemorative events, rather than monuments. That is, each inscription, section or plaque added to a monument is recorded in separate rows of the database, to avoid flattening time periods and individuals. (where 1 includes the erecting of the monument, and the subsequent additions follow numerically).</p>  <p>1 Monument erected in 1910 to commemorate R.H. Hill</p> <p>2 Addition of inscription in 1955 to commemorate his wife <u>Alwilda</u></p>
5	Location	Name of cemetery or church
6	Inscription	Complete inscription correlated with a commemorative event.

10	Maker	If noted (usually located near base or on back)
11	LxWxH	<p>Dimensions of the model, length by width by height</p>
12	Condition	<p>Basic description of the condition of the monument at the time of recording: Excellent, Good, Fair, or Poor.</p> <p>Recognising the impact of lichen, pitting, breakage, weathering, wearing.</p>
13	Date of Monument	Estimated date that the monument was erected
14	Date of Death	Commemorated date of death of the individual.
